

Showcase your creative talent! Win Prizes!

FRCS elementary students are invited to enter the 2025 Studio Art Show, where 1st, 2nd, and 3rd prizes will be awarded in each of four categories: 1st-3rd grade boys; 1st-3rd grade girls; 4th-6th grade boys; and 4th-6th grade girls. Judges will look for "Best Craftsmanship" and "Most Creative" when making their selections. Each student is allowed to enter no more than one 2D piece and one 3D piece. All artwork must be completed outside of school (including all supplies) and 100% by the student (no help from others). Pieces of any size are welcome.

GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION

All 2D (flat) artwork should be turned into the elementary art room with the artist's name, grade/section on the piece

All 3D artwork (e.g., sculptures) must be photographed; a color print of this photo should be turned into the elementary art room with the artist's name, grade/section on the photo

All artwork must be ORIGINAL; avoid creating from existing franchises, such as Marvel, DC Comics, video games, anime, Disney, etc.; avoid copying something that gives you step-by-step instructions; you can be inspired by other work but do not copy

No submission form is required; just bring the finished artwork or photograph to the elementary art room with the artist's name and grade/grade section on it (e.g., Ariel Johns, 3B)

Parents are allowed to assist with photographing 3D artwork; 2D artwork should be handed in as-is (no photos required)

If you have questions, please check with the elementary art teacher
