- You must be ready to perform your act AT AUDITIONS.
 There may not be changes to the act following auditions unless it is approved.
- Please be sure to bring a music track if you plan to use one, OR email beforehand (karaoke background track on You Tube is the preferred method)
- With the number of elementary students and anticipated number of acts, there will most likely be cuts. Please work hard to present your act just as you will perform it.
- Students may not be in more than two acts.
- Audition forms must be turned into the elementary office by Friday, February 7.
